Registration Details & Deadlines

- a) In view of the capacity of the venue, every school / institution may send **a maximum** of: 2 entries for Table Arrangement per category
- b) Registration form must be completed and submitted by 25 June 2024.

If you wish to register more than the above stipulated number of entries, kindly indicate the details of your reserve participants in the registration form. Approval is subject to availability of space at the venue and based on the total number of entries received from all schools and tertiary institutions.

Participation Fee

The participation fee is \$30 per student participant. Details for payment will be shared with successful registrants via email.

No refund will be made after payment is received upon confirmation of registration. However, replacement of participant(s) is allowed subject to approval by the Floral Harmony committee.

Awards

(a) The following will be awarded for each category:

Gold, Silver, and Bronze: Trophy and Certificate
Merit: Certificate of Merit

(b) All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation.

Awards Presentation Ceremony


The Awards Presentation Ceremony will be held on the same day, 3rd August 2024, 6.30 p.m. at the Centre-stage, Suntec Singapore, Level 4. Please be seated **30 minutes** before the start of the ceremony.

Collection of Floral Display

All floral displays belonging to the competitors will be available for collection by the competitors at the end of the exhibition at 10.00 p.m. on 6th August 2024 (Tuesday). Any displays left uncollected after 10.30 p.m. will be disposed of by the organisers as the space will be used for another competition setup.

Rules and Regulations (Table Arrangement)

- 1. Competitors must report at least 30 minutes before the start of the competition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any late competitor and any fee paid shall not be refunded. Should entry be granted based on goodwill, no extra time will be granted to the latecomer.
- 2. Successful registrants' participation fees must be paid in full. Entry passes will be given per participant and 1 accompanying adult. Additional tickets for participating schools are available for sale at 20% discount that can be purchased at this website https://go.gov.sg/sgf2024-disc20
- 3. Competition area will be cordoned off. Parents of participants are requested to stay out of the competition grounds. The floral design must be the individual work of the competitor. No teamwork or external help is allowed. Should the child require any help with cutting, they may approach the teachers on duty.
- 4. The floral design can be in free style.
- 5. The completed design <u>must not exceed 0.8 m (L) x 0.6 m (W) x 1.3 m (H)</u> and the stipulated dimensions must be adhered to throughout the design. No part of the completed design may exceed the dimensions given.
- 6. Competitors must bring <u>their own competition materials</u>, including but not limited to containers, vases, scissors, cutter, tools, wire, cellulose tape and <u>thoroughly soaked floral foam</u> to the competition venue. If necessary, the young competitors will need to bring their own stools to help them see better.
- 7. Competitors will be provided with a surprise package of flowers.
- 8. Competitors <u>must use at least 60%</u> of the materials provided in their work.
- 9. All fresh materials should be attached to a water source (e.g. test-tube) or water-retaining material (e.g. floral foam) as the floral creations will be exhibited for 4 days.
- 10. Competitors may enhance their design using other materials but <u>NO fresh/ artificial flowers</u> and leaves (other than those supplied by the organisers); and <u>NO live animals</u> such as live fishes are allowed. Any violation of this rule will result in disqualification of the entry. However, decorative items such as figurines, ribbons, pebbles etc. are allowed.



- 11. Competitors will be given 1 hour to complete their floral designs. No extension of time is allowed. Incomplete work will be judged as it is.
- 12. All decisions made by the judges are final. No correspondence will be considered.
- 13. The organisers reserve the right to use the photographs, information and design works of competitors in any medium of publication for publicity or record purposes as they deem fit.
