

RULES OF COMPETITION & EXHIBITION

1. Participation

The SGF Orchid Show is both a competition and an exhibition, open to members of the public. All participants shall abide by these rules of competition and exhibition.

2. Registration

- Exhibitors are encouraged to register their plants online at
<https://orchidshow.ossea.org.sg>
- The Plant Registration App will go ‘live’ on Wednesday 9 July at 12.00 a.m.
- Exhibitors may enter plants under their own name or under a pseudonym. Corporate or organizational names are allowed. Joint entries are not allowed.
- Every plant entry will be assigned a unique registration number generated online, which must be handwritten in bold by permanent marker pen on a tag firmly secured to the plant and displayed clearly.
- Inquiries about registration procedure may be sent via email to

3. Submission

- Registered plants must be delivered to the designated Plant Submission Point at the National Orchid Garden (NOG) Office on Tyersall Road. See maps for directions from all accessible routes.
- Exhibitors should submit these plants on Wednesday 16 July, between 9 a.m. and 4.00 p.m., and unload them as expeditiously as possible to avoid congestion.
- Vehicle access to the Exhibition Area is strictly for the transportation of plant exhibits and other exhibition materials. Privately owned vehicles must otherwise use the designated carparks.
- Registrars will check online registration records to ensure that details entered match the actual plants submitted. Exhibitors shall leave the premises after plant submission.

4. Identification and Verification

Registered plants may compete only when they have been correctly identified by formally recognized names and parentage. OrchidRoots is a recommended web-based tool that helps to facilitate the visual identification of orchid species and hybrids by name. It may be accessed online at: <https://www.orchidroots.com/>.

Orchid names are valid only when they have been verified as accepted (and not a synonym) by the following taxonomic authorities:

- For species, Kew's Plants of the World Online at <http://powo.science.kew.org>.
- For hybrids, the RHS International Orchid Register at
<http://apps.rhs.org.uk/horticulturaldatabase/orchidregister/orchidregister.asp>.

5. Judging

- Show and award judging will be conducted in the designated Judging Zones on Thursday 17 July from 8.00 a.m. onwards.
- Judges allocated to respective judging teams will adjudicate only the competition plants arranged by class in those sections the teams are assigned. Each team will be headed by a lead judge and assisted by at least one steward. The lead judge shall ensure that judging is conducted in an orderly, timely manner without prejudice and may exercise the casting vote in the event of a tie. The stewards shall assist judges in identifying and examining all entries under their purview, record the winners in all classes adjudicated by the team, and affix appropriate insignia to those plants.
- Prizes and awards will be granted solely based on merit and at the discretion of judging teams.
 - Challenge Cups may be given to overall winners in specific categories.
 - Ribbon Rosettes may be given to winners ranked First, Second and Third in every class.
 - The Judges Commendation (JC) may be given to a plant that might not qualify for a quality award but nonetheless deserves special recognition for some noteworthy attribute or aspect of botanical, horticultural or historical importance, cited specifically as the reason for commendation. This may include floral attributes (e.g. flower count, arrangement, size, form, coloration, scent etc.), the history, rarity or novelty of the plant in cultivation, accomplishment in cultivation and aesthetics of overall presentation.

- OSSEA award judging will be conducted for plants of truly improved or desirably innovative quality, which are nominated by OSSEA judges.
 - The High Commendation Certificate (HCC), Award of Merit (AM) or First Class Certificate (FCC) may be bestowed on a plant in recognition of outstanding flower quality in the percentile score range of 75-79, 80-89 and 90-100 points, respectively.
- The Chair of Judging shall preside over all judging activities, deciding the combining or creation of classes as merited, the classification of any plant difficult to place, the final outcome if a lead judge cannot exercise the casting vote impartially, the shortlist of nominations for award judging and the mode of judging (by appreciation or point scoring).
- Where more than one plant is potted or mounted, only the best will be judged. For *Papilionanthe* and other strongly terete monopodials, up to five plant stems may be potted and then judged collectively as one
- Except for *Phalaenopsis* and *Oncidium* Alliance exhibits, stakes or wires must be unobtrusive, must not touch any part of any flower (including the pedicel) and must not extend beyond the first flower on any inflorescence.

6. Rejection

Plants considered unacceptable for competition and exhibition include those newly jungle collected, disbudded, infected by disease, infested with pests/parasites, or otherwise unpresentable for lack of grooming.

7. Disclaimer

All plants will be handled with care, but exhibitors must bear in mind that they participate at their own risk. The Show Organizers shall not be liable to exhibitors for any loss or damage in respect of plants submitted.

8. Disqualification

Any breach of these rules may lead to disqualification of the plant or the participant concerned. Any appeal, request for clarification or complaint must be directed to the Chair of Judging or Show Organizers, as appropriate, whose decision shall be taken as final.

9. Maintenance and Collection

- Scheduled maintenance of show plants will be carried out daily, including watering at 7.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. for plants exhibited indoors and as appropriate for plants exhibited outdoors depending on weather conditions.
- Exhibitors are not allowed to remove or water their plants without permission from the Show Organizers, which may be sought via email sent to whang_lay_keng@nparks.gov.sg.
- The Show Organizers may remove or replace plants or flowers unable to last the full duration of the Show. Exhibitors whose plants are removed from the display will be duly notified.
- Show plants will be otherwise de-registered for collection by their respective exhibitors according to the following schedule:
 - Professional (Farmer/Nurseryman) Exhibitors: Monday 28 July, 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
 - Amateur (Hobbyist) Exhibitors: Sunday 27 July, after 7.00 p.m., or Monday 28 July, 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.
